

# SYNOPSIS

*“Peter Pan & Wendy” tells the story of a magical journey that Wendy and her brothers Michael and John take to Neverland with Peter Pan, the boy who never grew up. The children meet Peter Pan after he loses his shadow when he and his fairy friend Tinker Bell visit the children’s nursery. When Peter tells Wendy and her brothers that they can come away to enchanted Neverland and never grow old, they fly past “the second star to the right and straight on ‘til morning”, and discover Peter’s home.*

*The children meet the orphaned Lost Boys, who beg Wendy to be their mother, and build her a beautiful house. All sorts of adventures follow – John and Michael meet the Red Indian Princess Tigerlily, and they and the princess are captured by the evil Captain Hook, who uses them as bait to lead his long-time enemy Peter Pan into a trap; Wendy meets the mermaids, and after the children are reunited they enjoy a party with the Red Indians. Peter Pan, Wendy and her brothers, and Tinker Bell, wage many brave battles against the pirates and Captain Hook, but eventually good overcomes evil, and the children triumph.*

*Peter Pan wants Wendy to stay in Neverland, so that neither of them will grow up, but she and her brothers find that, although they have had a wonderful journey, it is time to return to the real world and their loving mother. The children take the Lost Boys with them, and Peter Pan and Tinker Bell return to their magical adventures, and a life where they will never grow up.*


## A Few Words From Miss Francesca
