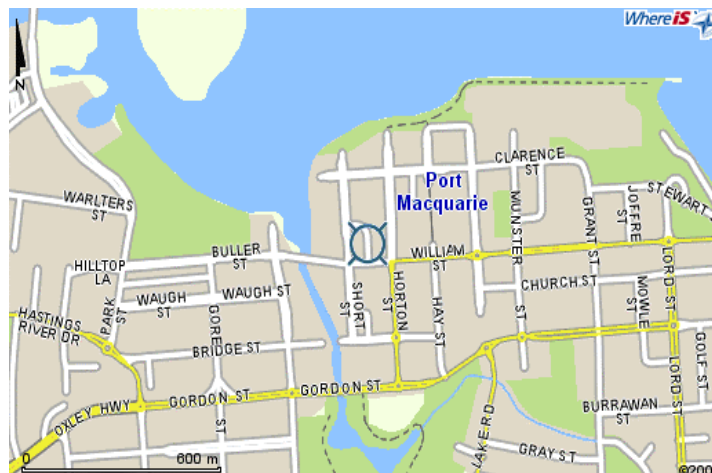

To help the Eisteddfod run smoothly for us all, we have a few small things to remember. Some of these are rules, of the Eisteddfod society and I would ask you to please abide by them. All studio costumes will be taken to the PCYC by the group representatives. They will be given out to the participating children, and collected straight after their performances. No studio costumes are to be taken home. To ensure that all the costumes are kept clean for the Eisteddfod, there is to be no eating in costumes. Costumes should be covered when entering the auditorium at all times. Please remember no jewellery is to be worn on stage. Earrings, rings and visible body piercing should be removed.

Port Macquarie Eisteddfod society has hired the services of professional video and photographic companies. There are to be no private cameras in the auditorium. The use of private video or still cameras could result in the studio being disqualified from the competition. Mobile phones and camera phones are not to be used in the dressing rooms and are to be turned off while in the auditorium. Please don't leave valuables unattended in the dressing rooms. It would be best to leave these things at home. Hoping that we all have a fantastic weekend and good luck to everybody taking part!
