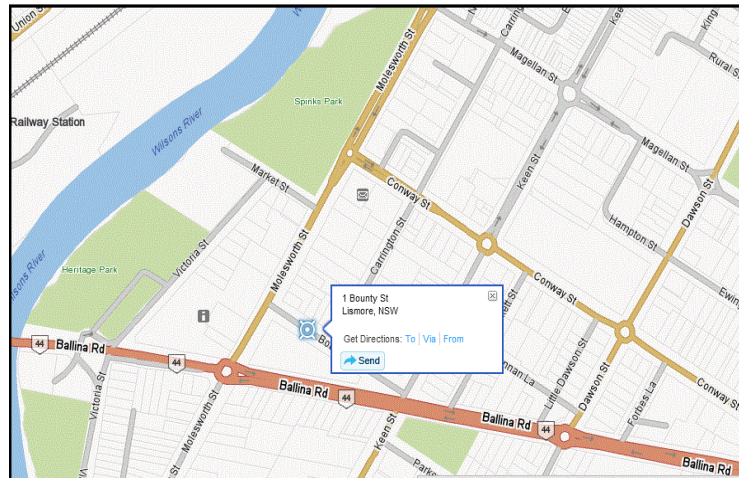


**LISMORE EISTEDDFOD

The Lismore Eisteddfod Group weekend commences on Friday the 17th of September at 8.30 am. Please arrive with hair and make-up done. To enable you, competitors and family members to watch a Group performance at the Lismore Eisteddfod you can purchase tickets to gain entry to the Auditorium. There are only two sessions, Troupe day Saturday 17th Sept(Full day flat rate-\$12) and Troupe day Sunday 18th Sept(Full day flat rate-\$12). Students/pensioners are \$10.

Parents/carers are requested to take their children to the dressing room where they can prepare them for the competition.

As all female competitors are in one dressing room, it will be necessary for all students to arrive with their hair and make-up done. A male dressing room will also be available. There will be limited facilities. The group representatives are only responsible for the transportation of the costumes and each parent is requested to prepare their own child with their costume and head piece. The Group rep. will not be dressing the whole group. After your child has danced please pick them up from the dressing room area promptly or help them change for their next dance.

There is only one starting time given for each day - 8.30 am and one ticket price for the whole day. This does make it hard to estimate arrival times and break times. As we are new to this Eisteddfod, we will be taking along a lot of patience and a good sense of humour.

To help the Eisteddfod run smoothly for us all, we have a few small things to remember. Some of these are rules, of the Eisteddfod society and I would ask you to please abide by them. All studio costumes will be taken to the Lismore City Hall by the group representatives. They will be given out to the participating children, and collected straight after their performances. **No studio costumes are to be taken home.** To ensure that all the costumes are kept clean for the Eisteddfod, there is to be no eating in costumes. Costumes should be covered when entering the auditorium at all times. Please remember no jewellery is to be worn on stage. Earrings, rings and visible body piercing should be removed at home to avoid loss.

The Lismore Eisteddfod society has hired the services of professional video and photographic companies. There are to be no private cameras in the auditorium. The use of private video or still cameras could result in the studio being disqualified from the competition. Mobile phones and camera phones are not to be used in the dressing rooms and are to be turned off while in the auditorium. Please don't leave valuables unattended in the dressing room. It would be best to leave these things at home. Hoping that we all have a fantastic weekend and good luck to everybody taking part!
